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I would like to suggest that it might be able to bring the current system of CEO election as stated in the Basic Law to a more democratic footing without rewriting the basic law and thus have a higher chance of winning the approval from the People's Congress in China: ---

According to the Annex I paragraph 3, HKSAR government can enact electoral law "in accordance with the principles of democracy and openness". Therefore, it is possible for HKSAR government to write in the local electoral law to hold the member of electoral committee accountable for their votes. The members of electoral committee should be generated by open election. As long as the accountability is there, the system is still democratic.
