

Subject: A1(3) The Chief Executive (CE) is appointed by the CPG. He is accountable to both the CPG and the HKSAR


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The CE shall be selected by elections or consultation locally. The selection method is specified in the light of actual situation in HKSAR. 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actual situaion is refer to actual situation of HKSAR. Don't try to refer to the actual situation of PRC, read the Bacis Law.


Actual situation should be the views of majority Hong Kong people. Government is for the people, from the pepole and by the people.

Subject: A2(2) How 'gradual and orderly progress' should be understood

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
