


Subject:A1(2) HKSAR comes directly under the CPG















Subject: A1(3) The Chief Executive (CE) is appointed by the CPG. He is accountable to both the CPG and the HKSAR




There is no conflict on these two duties.

Why do you think there is a problem on this?











Subject:A2(2) How 'gradual and orderly progress' should be understood












