A1(3) The Chief Executive (CE) is appointed by the CPG. He is accountable to both the CPG and the HKSAR










The CE should be a carefully selected person who is capable of promoting harmonious working relationship with the CPG.



3/ Conduct affairs as authorized by CA

Subject: A2(2) How 'gradual and orderly progress' should be understood




