




Subject: A2(1) What should 'actual situation' constitute

    Move To: 

'Actual situation' should mean what is happening at this point of time in Hong Kong, not what has happened 5 years ago nor what will be happening 5 years later. 'Actual' also means an objective view of the situation, not the government's own view or the view of any particular interest group/party. It should be an objective assessment of the situation as seen by the majority of the public of the HKSAR.

In this context, the assessment should include the education level of people of HK, the interest of the people in HK in participating in political activity, and the experience and maturity of HK people in managing the government and political framework.
