

Subject: Comments



The recently concluded election for legislative council members raises concerns about the manner in which Legco members are elected. I find that voting for lists of candidates instead of individual candidates does not reflect my choice. Instead, I suggest that voters vote for specific candidates for a given district. In addition, the political parties should be given additional members based on the percentage of votes their parties receive whereby they can appoint specific members to Legco. This way, minority political parties may also have adequate representation.

In addition, I support universal suffrage for choosing the Chief Executive as soon as possible.
