I would like to offer my view and suggestion for the future constitutional development of Hong Kong as follows.

Election Committee

Prior to universal suffrage become reality, the Election Committee should enlarge to at least 1,600 members in order to broaden the representations from comprehensive sectors in the society.

Tourism Functional Constituency

In view of the present unbalance situation of voter formation in this Constituency of which 1,300 travel agents versus around 100 hotels and 60 airlines. It might be advisable to institute an additional Constituency for hotel and airlines to accommodate electoral opportunity for contestant from these 2 sectors.

Further more, since the size of companies in this Constituency varied from a 2 to 3 person small travel agent to companies (travel agent / hotel / airlines) which employ hundreds or thousands employee. Therefore one vote per company is inaccurate to reflect the real voice from the entire sector.

To ensure fairness and the relevant industry sectors' interests have fully represented, I would suggest a company in the Tourism Constituency should entitled up to 10 votes depending on the size reflected by number of staff. It is definitely not a new idea as prior to 1995, each company had up to 6 votes in the Functional Constituency.

I hope the Constituency Development Task Force can consider the above suggestions to ensure well balance, fairness and diverse representation in the society upon next election of Chief Executive Election and the Legislative Council 2008.
