Since the current voting system for the geographical constituencies is based on a proportional approach, it may not make sense to further "divide" the voters into the five "constituencies".

I propose that the five geographical constituencies should be removed and all lists should be nominated under the one big constituency, if the proportional approach is to be retained. This would eliminate the duplication implied by the two concepts - constituency and proportional system.

The removal of the geographical constituencies will enable the votes to choose their preferred candidate without the barrier of having to be living in the "right" district.
