HKCII is a Chamber of Insurance Intermediaries, members of which are of Agents and Brokers of both Life and General Insurance. It is our belief that Agents and Brokers both are performing duties of bridging between the Insurance Buyers and Insurers, and that they are all currently regulated by law to practice as such and as an important component as Insurers in the Insurance Industry.

We are therefore writing to express that the current voters for our constituency being restricted only to one vote for one Insurance Company are not adequately representing the voice and interests of the whole industry. We are strongly of the opinion that Insurance Intermediaries, either our members or not, must be given the right to vote. Whether a firm or an association of Insurance Intermediaries, or else shall be consider as a unit of voters, we are open-minded for discussion among our industry for consensus in the next election.
