Constitutional Development

In the light of the scope for amendments referred to in the recent NPCSC's decision, we would propose that the 2008 Legislative Council should reserve at least two seats in the functional constituency to represent Civil Servants. Alternatively, the number of seats in the Labour functional constituency could be expanded to accommodate such representation with electors coming from civil servants.

This is because there are over 160,000 civil servants in Hong Kong. Adding their family members will make up a total population of more than 500,000. At present there is no political representation for this group of population in the Legislative Council; and hence their interests have not been properly taken care of and that there exists a lot of misconception on the role played by civil servants in the society.
