

Proposal for the Election of Chief Executive in 2007

For the Election of the Chief Executive (CE) in year 2007, I propose the following:

Election Committee

1. The <u>Election Committee</u> shall be composed of two sub-committees: (1) the <u>Nomination Committee</u>, and (2) the <u>Voting Committee</u>.

Nomination Committee

- 2. The Nomination Committee shall have 800 members, and shall be composed of members from the following four sectors:
 - a. 200 members from the industrial, commercial and financial sectors
 - b. 200 members from the professions
 - c. 200 members from the labor, social services, religious and other sectors
 - d. 200 members from members of the Legislative Council, representatives of district-based organizations, Hong Kong deputies to the National People's Congress, and representatives of Hong Kong members of the National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference
- 3. The Nomination Committee is responsible for the nomination of CE candidates (and nomination *only*, not voting).
- 4. Candidates for the office of CE may be nominated jointly by not less than 100 members, and not more than 200 members of the Nomination Committee. Each member may nominate only one candidate. In addition, the candidate is required to obtain no less than 20 nominations from each of the four sectors composing the Nomination Committee (as listed above in 2).

Voting Committee

- 5. The Voting Committee shave have 10,000 members, randomly chosen (e.g., by lottery) among the Registered Voters of Hong Kong.
- 6. The Voting Committee is responsible for the voting of the CE.

Other Amendments

7. Cap. 569 s 5 is to be amended to allow an elected CE candidate to be a political party member.
