The Fourth Report of the Constitutional Development Task Force

We are a Hong Kong based company and feel that we shall be represented.

- 1. The number of seats in Legislative Council should be increased to allow wider representation.
- 2. The number of seats in the Functional Constituency should be increased to reflect the contribution of the industry/sector to the society and the economy.
- 3. We strongly request that the construction industry should have its individual seat in the Functional Constituencies. Our view is based on the following reasons:
 - a) Construction industry is very important to Hong Kong economy. In the last few years, the construction industry has around 60 to 80 billions of turnover.
 - b) The industry employs 300,000 plus people. The construction industry has a direct impact on over hundred thousands' families with more than a million population, that is over 16% of the total population.
- Corporate voting arrangement should be retained for the Functional Constituency seats. In the case of our industry, many of our corporate voters are professionals and in senior managerial positions. They believe in partnership and team spirit, which are the core values of Hong Kong, and they will continue put them into practice.
