Your Excellency

We have the following demands regarding constitutional matters.

1. In accordance with the Basic Law provision Minority Communities can represent themselves in the Legislative Council. Minority Communities, because of their size of the population and their scattered way of living in Hong Kong can not build up sufficiently strong constituency for themselves. It means they hardly win any competitive elections. Therefore the better way is through Functional Constituencies. **We demand that a constituency may be created for minority communities in the Functional Constituencies to represent themselves in the Legislative Council.**
2. Minority communities should be represented in the District Councils. **Appointment methods may be used and minimum of 5% of 530 District Councillors be returned to the respective 18 districts.**
3. Minority communities' members may fairly be represented in all the Heung Yee Kuks.
4. **Minority communities may fairly be represented in the Election Committee.**
